## **CMLT488 Genres (3 Credits)**

A study of a recognized literary form, such as tragedy, film, satire, literary criticism, comedy, tragicomedy, etc.

**Repeatable to:** 6 credits if content differs.

## **CMLT498 Selected Topics in Comparative Studies (3 Credits)**

### **CMLT639 Studies in the Renaissance (3 Credits)**

**Repeatable to:** 9 credits.

### **CMLT649 Studies in Eighteenth Century Literature (3 Credits)**

Studies in eighteenth century literature: as announced.

**Repeatable to:** 9 credits.

### **CMLT658 Studies in Romanticism (3 Credits)**

Studies in romanticism: as announced.

**Repeatable to:** 9 credits.

### **CMLT679 Topics in Comparative Studies (3 Credits)**

Seminar in modern and contemporary literature: as announced.

**Repeatable to:** 9 credits.

### **CMLT699 Independent Study (1-6 Credits)**

Research and writing on specific readings on a topic selected by the student which is approved and supervised by a faculty member.

**Restriction:** Permission of instructor.

**Repeatable to:** 9 credits if content differs.

### **CMLT709 Seminar in Transnational Literatures and Cultures (3 Credits)**

Examines cultural and political ideas as they circulate across nations in literary and/or other forms (film, song, visual culture, digital works, etc.) in both historical and modern-day contexts.

**Cross-listed with:** ENGL709.

**Restriction:** Permission of ARHU-English Department.

**Repeatable to:** 9 credits if content differs.

### **CMLT788 Practicum in Comparative Studies (1-6 Credits)**

Practical professional training for individuals and groups of students in supervised settings.

**Prerequisite:** Permission of ARHU-English department.

**Repeatable to:** 20 credits if content differs.
